



Greece: Opportunities for U.S. Companies Trans Adriatic Pipeline Corridor Construction

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Summary

The Southern Gas Corridor (SGC) is a 2,175 mile pipeline with an estimated investment budget of US \$45 billion. Once completed, the SGC will cross over six countries: Azerbaijan, Georgia, Turkey, Greece, Albania, and Italy.

The Trans Adriatic Pipeline (TAP) AG is a company established to plan, develop and build the TAP natural gas pipeline passing over Greece, Albania, and Italy. The project is planned to start in 2016 with the majority of the contracts finalized by the end of 2015.

The TAP pipeline will transport gas from the Trans Anatolian Pipeline (TANAP) to Greece, Albania, Italy, and further to Western Europe. The TAP foreign direct investment in Greece is estimated at approximately \$1.9 billion.
